We have institutionalized in Spain the Comic Day, which we will celebrate on March 17, in recognition of the contribution of comics to culture. We hope you will share with us many of the activities we will be celebrating.

# SPAIN, A LONG TRADITION OF COMICS CREATION

Throughout history, Spain has been known for giving birth to some of the world's most important creators in disciplines such as painting, music, cinema, and literature, and now it is also doing so in such a stimulating medium as Comic, the ninth art.

Spain, which traditionally has been and is one of the world powers in the publishing industry, has a long tradition in the creation and publication of comics, dating back to the popular magazines that sold hundreds of thousands of copies at the beginning of the last century, and which forged several generations of readers. Today it is a mature market where more than 4,000 new titles are published annually, covering a multitude of genres and styles aimed at all types of audiences. This catalogue, produced for Spain's participation as Guest of Honor at the Frankfurt Book Fair 2022, aims to highlight to the world the talent of Spanish authors, who for more than 100

years have been able to adapt to changing trends, being highly appreciated by international publishers and readers.

Many Spanish authors work successfully for the North American market, while others succeed with series of their own creation in markets as demanding as the Franco-Belgian. At the same time, a legion of creators venture, hand in hand with Spanish publishers, in the production of their own original works, which are the protagonists of this catalogue. They are works conceived for the Spanish market, known for its diversity and originality, but aimed to be exploited and enjoyed internationally.

We have invited Spanish publishers to select their most representative works of the last 4 years and the result is the collection of 188 comics that populate these pages, which embrace very diverse genres, styles, formats, and readers, and which are a good example of the overflowing creativity of Spanish authors and the firm commitment of Spanish publishers to production.

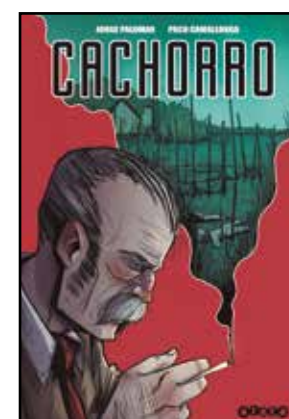
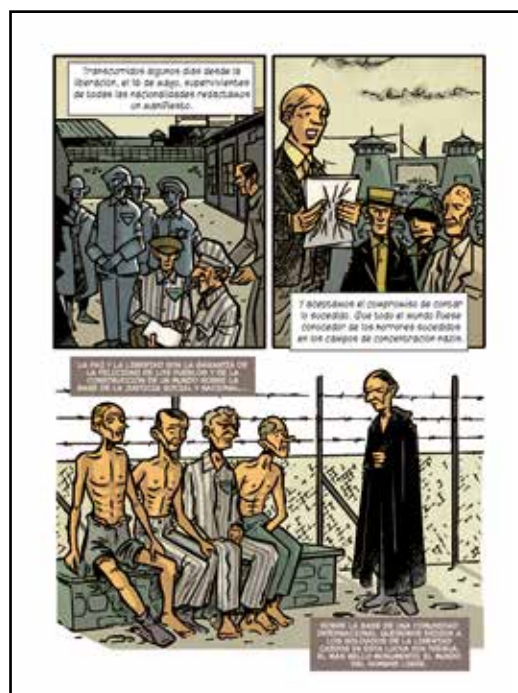


## I will always wait for your return Jordi Peidro

From his memories he tells the tragedy of the Spanish Republicans: the passage through the border, the refugee camps, the Maginot line, the flight to Switzerland ... but nothing, not even being combated on the battlefield, prepared him for what was to come: Mathausen. There the prisoners sing a song, tinged with nostalgia and hope. Its title: I will always wait for your return.

For a time, the German submarine fleet (the Kriegsmarine), sank every British merchant ship that crossed the ocean with supplies, causing great damage to the British navy. But in 1943, thanks to sonar, more accurate depth charges and Allied aircraft with greater flight range and powerful radar, German submersibles became an easy prey.

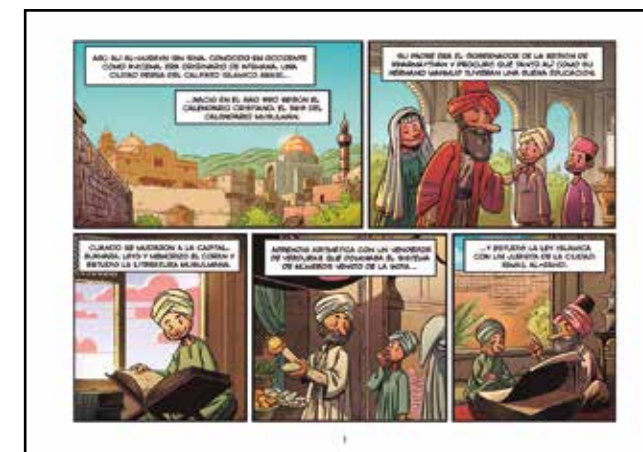
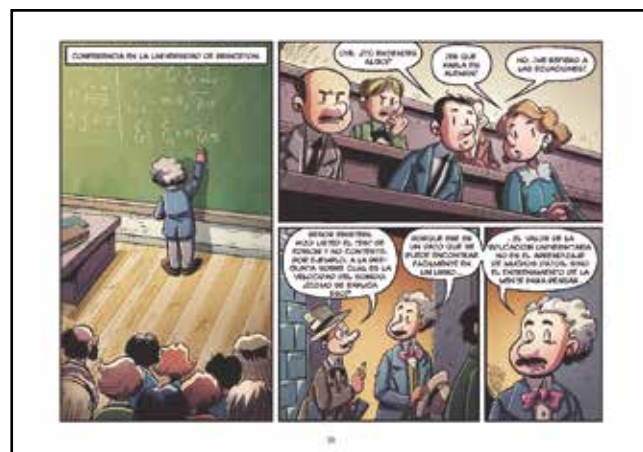
## Avicenna, the canon of medicine

Avicenna was a Persian physician and philosopher who lived during the 9th and 10th centuries in present-day Iran. He wrote many books on both disciplines, the best known of which is The Canon of Medicine. In this book he compiled the medical knowledge of his time by combining medieval Islamic medicine, the ancient classical tradition, and his own personal experience. The Canon of Medicine was translated into Latin and Hebrew and rapidly spread throughout Europe, where it was the reference work in medical practice for at least five hundred years.

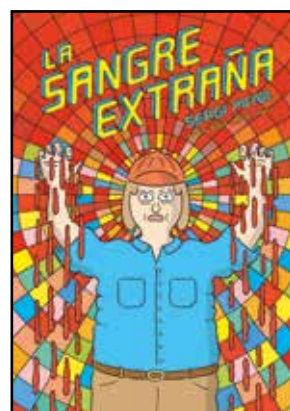




# APA APA CÓMICS

Adrián Bago, or someone similar to Adrián Bago, -who, according to him, is not him, but has the same name and looks exactly like him- saves a lot of money from therapy sharing with us his failures, his fears, his mistakes and sexual adventures. A rough and detailed drawing, a story full of political, social and personal reflections... all this builds up a "generational portrait" that will reach everyone as we embrace something similar to youth where job insecurity is our daily bread.

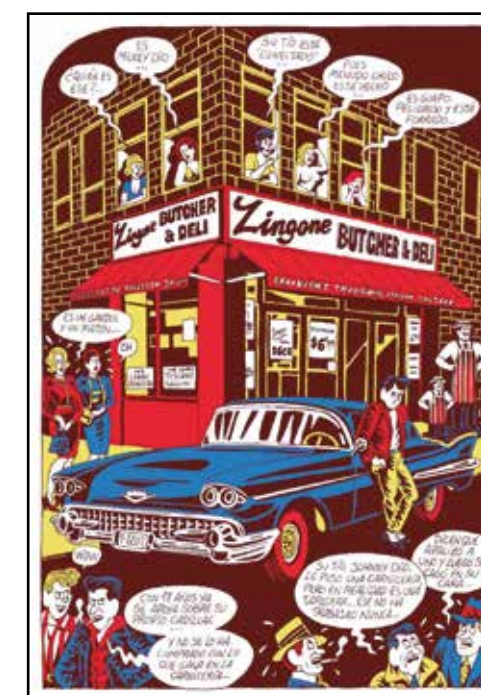
# Comic artist, slice of life

Phantastykon Satanas provokes at least three questions: What atrocity is this? What was the need to publish this book? And what the fuck is going on in this guy's head? Sadomasochism and extreme cruelty, the mother's womb torn apart and desecrated, anuses and urethras, the brains, the eyes... all torn apart. And all of this as we search for the alpha and the omega, for the meaning of existence and creation. Perverse rituals, epic worlds and extreme acts of such caliber that force us to take a distance and contemplate these scenes from the outside, as if it were an anguishing spectacle, between naive and baroque, overwhelming and, why not say it, disgusting.

He rises from being a butcher's assistant to a bank executive. From his new position, he will launder funds from the gangland and engage in drug trafficking, stolen cars sale and contract killings. His efficiency in these fields will get him admitted in the honorata societat despite of his Calabrian origin. From then on, he will rub shoulders with the Petrosino family, meet Big Frank Catalano and develop a brilliant crime career from the Gemini Lounge, a slum of his own in which, from time to time, he demonstrates his experience as a butcher.

Descendant of Queen Urraca of Leon, the first woman to rule a kingdom in Occident, granddaughter of Leonor of Aquitaine, niece of Richard the Lionheart and daughter of Leonor of Plantagenet and Alfonso VIII of Castile, she was queen of Leon by her marriage to Alfonso IX and briefly queen of Castile before abdicating to her son Ferdinand. She was brilliant, cultured, audacious, devout, but unscrupulous when it came to removing the obstacles that stood in her way. She decided to work hard for the good of her son, King Ferdinand III, and she focused all her efforts on it, obtaining two crowns for him. She never withdrew from public affairs. She remained exercising her influence and intervening in them decisively.

That same night, a man's throat is slit at the foot of the statue and the murderer was none other than Galdós's nurse, Elena. Ten years earlier, Galdós feels lost. His age and loss of sight affect him enormously and Madrid seems overwhelming, to such a degree that he finds solace in escaping to his memories when he cannot escape to Santander. It is then that he meets Elena, a disgraced girl nicknamed "la Miseria" ("the Misery"), whom he takes in as a protégée. Elena's life is as Galdosian as any of the author's own novels.
